

Online Ordering of Family Search Microfilm Now Available

Ordering microfilmed records from the Family History Library in Salt Lake City is now easier than ever thanks to their new online ordering program. Instead of ordering and paying through your local Family History Center/Library, you can now order and pay online in a few easy steps. The first step is to create a free account with Family Search. If you already have an account, simply go to their new film ordering page: www.familysearch.org/films, and sign in. The rest is easy, much like ordering from any online vendor. Once the film arrives, you will receive an email notification that it is available to be used at your local Family History Center. You will need to check with your local Family History Center to make sure they are participating in the online ordering of microfilm. Be sure to also check when the Family History Center is open.

ONLINE FILM ORDERING PROCESS

- 1. Go to: https://film.familysearch.org
- 2. In the upper right hand corner, click on Sign In

3. If you already have an LDS account, enter your username & password. If you don't have an LDS account, scroll down to the *Create a New Account* button, click and follow directions to create a new account.

4. On your first time ordering films, click on *My Account* (left side just below the words Online Film Ordering) and fill in your billing address, then click save.

5. Then select (from the right side list) *My Family History Center*. Click on *Find New FHC*, enter United States, your state, then scroll down to your local Family History Center (where you want to read the film) and click in the box to the left. Save.

6. Now, click on Place an Order (right side) select loan type, select currency (USD), enter the Film Number you wish to order and click *Add to Cart*. When you have entered all films/fiche, click *Proceed to Checkout*.

7. Select your Billing Information & follow directions. You may use either a credit card or your PayPal account. If you use your PayPal account, you will have to log in to your PayPal account to complete the order processing.
