## **Researchers Beware: The Potential Perils of Online Genealogy**

is one of the many articles found, ironically, on the internet listing the dangers of using such resources exclusively to research your family history.

*Stolen intellectual property* is cited as a problem as companies such as ancestry.com links to findagrave.com due to one company buying another. ALL the information contributed by folks' shared blogs and calendar posts can now be used by ancestry.com as they wish.

*Credit thieves* often take other people's hard-earned research and claim it as their own. This group might seek you out and offer to share their information (some for a price) then give back what you found in the first place!

*Historical Viruses* raise their heads by way of a veritable forest of inaccurate and/or unverified genealogical trees.

These potential perils can be avoided by posting images that you personally own citing your ownership, carefully managing the privacy settings on your subscription sites, and – most importantly in my opinion – belonging to the Middlebrooks Family Association. Not only will a researcher have access to a wealth of information but also will have a network of people with whom to share ideas and ask questions. Real People!!

\*\*Under "Your Middlebrooks Ancestry Information" I can find Detailed Info (persons born before 1881), Outline Descendant Report (persons born 1920 or earlier) and my favorite, Person Index (list of all people by name).

\*\*This type of information on Joseph (b. 1610 in England) is NEW!

\*\*Publications from 2005 are available as well as Articles of Interest. There is a Document Library!

Back to the REAL PEOPLE reference .... On the Contact Us page, you will find names of officers, board members, ancestor team leaders, and coordinators of on-going projects. Just click on the name and there's an email for your convenience.
